BREAST CANCER AWARENESS

2020 has been a tough year due to the pandemic and it has reminded us of how vulnerable we can be and how important it is to take care of our health. It has also reminded us that we need to be careful and caring towards ourselves, our friends and our colleagues.

October is internationally known as Breast Cancer Awareness Month, and Covid-19 doesn't have to be a reason to postpone a breast cancer screening. Breast cancer is the most common cancer and the second most common cause of cancer deaths, but this can be prevented if diagnosed and treated early.

With the purpose of raising awareness of the issue, we created a 'Pink Day' in all three Amdaris Centres (United Kingdom, Romania, Moldova). SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT INTERNSHIP

At Amdaris we believe knowledge provides opportunity and should be shared freely. Twice a year we offer a three-month Software Development Internship Programme which is divided into three complex modules. Amdaris interns have daily presentations, assignments and homework. Each module is followed by a theoretical and practical exam. In order to graduate, interns need to create a Web Application using all their accumulated knowledge. For a more effective learning process, each intern is assigned an individual mentor who gives support and advice when needed. There are around 30 Amdaris internship graduate placements each year.

This year was challenging because of the pandemic, but we did not postpone the knowledge-sharing element of the internship; we ran it online. If we can work remotely, we can learn remotely too.

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

PROGRAMMING CLUBS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

We take our commitment to supporting educational initiatives very seriously. Alongside our current generation of IT specialists there is the next young technology talent, who we are keen to support.

In our Timisoara office, Amdaris has hosted the Coder Dojo* Community meeting where Coder Dojo mentors and champions have shared ideas, experiences, and activities planned for the future. Our people find it rewarding to host an event for young and passionate future IT talent.

Following this event several Amdarians held learning sessions with a group of pupils which focused on essential programming concepts

and the Scratch open-source system. Then we hosted a meet-up for future graduate students from the IT School Timisoara and delivered workshops on software development, QA and project management.

In challenging times, when schools switched to online education, many children didn't have access to a computer. Amdaris has donated computers to children from three schools in Ungheni District in Moldova and to the Educa Tim Association from Romania.

*CoderDojo and IT School Timisoara are community-based programming clubs for young people. By attending their classes children can learn to code, build a website, create an app or a game, and explore technology in an informal, creative and social environment.

ONLINE COURSES FOR THE E-LEARNING PLATFORM OF THE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY OF MOLDOVA (TUM)

We recognise the value of private companies investing in the world of education and are always ready to support initiatives to improve the quality of teaching and learning. Amdaris is the first company to participate in the development of the virtual training platform of the Faculty of Computers, Informatics and Microelectronics (FCIM) of the Technical University of Moldova (TUM).


FCIM has an online educational platform for digital content – ELSE (E-learning Space for Engineers). One of ELSE's major objectives was to transform passive digital content (previously used as course support material) into active and remotely accessible content. Amdaris recorded video courses on three topics to be placed on the UTM video streaming platform, giving students the opportunity for self-learning. Our content covered Developing ASP. NET MVC Web Applications; Developing Microsoft Azure and Web Services and HTML5 with JavaScript and CSS3.

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QA EXTRACURRICULAR ONLINE CLASSES FOR TUM STUDENTS

Amdaris QA testers launched a great initiative of delivering QA extracurricular classes for TUM students. The objective of this activity was to dispel the myths about testing by showing the students how amazing it can be. This initiative provided students with a real world learning opportunity and encourage them to consider this area as a future career. The course is focused on QA automation, demonstrating the technical aspects of the role of a QA tester. The lessons are held online, twice a week. It's an open course and everyone who is interested can join.

Amdaris will always support and celebrate such initiatives from its employees. The pride they take in sharing their knowledge is truly inspiring.



RENOVATING ONE OF THE LARGEST UNIVERSITY AUDITORIUMS IN MOLDOVA

Amdaris has started a new project in partnership with the Technical University of Moldova – the renovation of one of the largest auditoriums of the Faculty of Computers, Informatics and Microelectronics. In 2020 we held technical meetings to discuss the planning of the auditorium and initial design concepts. The renovation work is scheduled for early 2021. It consists of window replacement, thermal insulation, integral transformation of the auditorium interior, installation of modern sound systems/amphitheatre, projection and lighting, and wireless access to the public internet network.
